

## **SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. The pool is open from May to September during published hours when lifeguards are on duty. Entry into the pool area at any other time is strictly prohibited. Swimming is at your own risk.
- 2. You must be a member in good standing with a valid working entry access card to enter the pool.
- 3. All residents and their guests must access pool through the access gate located at the recreation center parking lot. No access will be granted through rear gate.
- 4. Upon entry you must check in and show your **entry access card** to the lifeguard located at the pool entrance gate. All residents must sign in and indicate number of guests on a log located with the lifeguard on duty.
- 5. Residents must have and use their own access card to enter the pool area. If you do not have a card or your card does not work you will not be granted access into the facility. All entry access cards will be retrieved and held with the lifeguard while you are at the facility.
  - a. Upon entry the lifeguard on duty will collect all access cards. Each card and the number of guests will be logged. Only two (2) guests per household, are allowed.
  - b. Upon exiting the facility residents must check out with the lifeguard at which time all access cards will be returned.
- All guests must be accompanied by community resident 18 years or older. Members are responsible for their guests. Admittance is limited to State Law requirements and the number or lifeguard-to-patron ratio.
- 7. Children under 13 years old must be accompanied and supervised by adult 18 years or older. Parents must be at arm's length at all times of any child under age six (6). Parents are primarily responsible for the supervision of their children using the baby pool. The baby pool is for non-swimmers only.
- 8. All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire. Only small floating items, upon pool manager's discretion, will be allowed in the pool.
- Loud music, Glass Containers, Alcoholic Beverages, Gum, Smoking and Pets are not allowed in the pool area at any time. No pool parties or climbing on rocks is permitted. No running or horseplay is ever allowed in the pool area.
- 10. There will be a **ten-minute rest period** every hour. All swimmers under 18 years of age must be out of the pool.
- 11. Please deposit all trash in the trash cans provided.
- 12. The lifeguard on duty has full authority to enforce all rules pertaining to the safety of the pool. Failure to follow the rules or lifeguard instructions may result in immediate removal from the pool area or suspension of use during pool season.
- 13. Use of these facilities is at your own risk. **911 phone** located in red box on the wall is for emergency use only.
- Profanity, Obscenity, Loud aggressive language, or Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Violators may be removed, fined and reported to the appropriate Law Enforcement Officials for further action. 281-914-1835
- 15. All heavy suntan oils cause filter damage. These should not be used in the pool.

The Pool facility will close at the pool season designated time, usually 8:00pm. Violators will be asked to leave by the Lifeguard or Law Enforcement. PLEASE NOTE CAMERA SURVELLIANCE IS 24 HOURS DAILY.

THE Lifeguard has the authority to contact the police in the event there is a unusual event or suspicious behavior on the property.

TO REPORT AN EMERGENCY, PLEASE CALL 911. TO REPORT AN ISSUE PLEASE CALL THE POOL COMPANY OR NOTIFY A LIFEGUARD.
